Nomination and Application Procedures

Nomination period	<p>Nomination of students is done online by the student's home university. Instructions are sent shortly before the nomination period.</p> <p>Autumn semester: March 15 – Apr 15 Spring and summer semesters: Sep 15 – Oct 15</p> <p>Note: Clinical placements within nursing should be communicated earlier (by email to coordinator): Feb 1 / Sep 1</p>
Application period	<p>Once the nominations have been submitted students receive an email with the log in details that are required for the online application.</p> <p>Autumn semester: April 1–15 Spring semester: Oct 1–15</p>
Supporting documents	<p>All supporting documents need to be uploaded in the application; no hard copies are to be sent to Lund University.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Official Transcript of Records including all courses and degrees taken as well as ongoing courses.• Letter of Motivation (describing your motivation to study at Lund University)• Certified copy of passport (see example on our website) <p>Read more about course/programme specific requirements: www.med.lu.se/english/exchange_studies/how_to_apply_for_exchange_studies</p>
Application process for exchange studies	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Nomination completed by student's home university.2. Email with application log in details sent to student by Lund University.3. Submit application including supporting documents.4. Apply for housing via LU Accommodation.5. Letter of Acceptance sent via email to the student by Lund University, along with the "Result of your application" showing the current status of course admission.6. Apply for Swedish Residence Permit for Studies using the Letter of Acceptance.7. Courses and Study Requirements

Course load	<p>A total of 30 credits are considered the normal full-time study load per semester. Lund University will not allow exchange students who are already admitted to full time studies to overload.</p>

Studying in Swedish	<p>Students with a background in Scandinavian studies or who have studied in a Nordic school system may be able to apply for courses with Swedish as the language of instruction. Find courses: www.lu.se/lubas/subjects</p> <p>Please note! If you find a course on a webpage stating "Kan bara sökas inom utbildningsprogram" – the course is not available.</p>
Language requirements	<p>It is recommended that the student's level of English language proficiency is equivalent to IELTS 6.5/ TOEFL 90.</p> <p>The Swedish language requirement for exchange students wishing to study Swedish-taught courses is "Svenska 3" or equivalent.</p>
Specific requirements	<p>The admission requirements (prerequisites) for each course can be found on the website of the relevant department.
